








A warm, grounded palette combining rich timber, soft linen, and creamy stone. The checkered tile adds character, while blue-grey tones bring a modern balance.



A cozy mix of modern curves and retro warmth, featuring mocha tones, travertine accents, and a playful checkerboard rug for timeless balance.












WAVERTON

A couple in their late 30s/early 40s are returning to Australia after years overseas. One works as a futures trader, the other as a journalist. They have a child starting school soon, are planning another, and have a new puppy. Their goal is to create a stable family home after years of travel.

They purchased land in Waverton for \$3.2M with plans for a duplex/semi-detached build, due for completion in 3 months. They'll live with the journalist's parents during construction, which will take place in 3 stages over ~18 months (first stage done in ~5 months).

The couple enjoy a cosmopolitan lifestyle, value sustainable and ethical design, and are keen on durable, original furnishings. They want their home to reflect concern for the environment and their children's future.

Budget: \$410K (excl. design fees) — \$200K living area, \$60K work/stay space, \$50K main bedroom, \$30K child's bedroom, \$20K nursery (\$100K). The journalist oversees budgeting and major design decisions.

Key interests:

- Journalist: colour psychology, how colour affects spaces.
- Futures trader: cooking/entertaining, living/outdoor areas.
- Both: contemporary aesthetic with sustainable finishes.

FF+E checklist includes: flooring, wall/ceiling finishes, internal/external colours, furniture, lighting, soft furnishings, artwork, window treatments, hardware, joinery, and accessories.











This scheme blends warm earthy textures with soft contemporary forms, creating a space that feels grounded, calm, and elevated.

On the material board, the mix of oak timber, terracotta tones, linen textures, and ribbed paneling sets a palette of natural warmth and organic tactility. The touch of woven detail adds depth, while the soft beige fabric keeps everything light and inviting.



The furniture board carries this palette through with curved silhouettes, creamy upholstery, and chunky sculptural pieces. The stone dining table, rounded sofa, and pale timber accents reinforce a look that is modern yet cosy. Artwork in blush and mocha tones ties the scheme together, adding personality and soft femininity.









This material board creates a look that's calm, fresh, and naturally refined. The palette blends soft travertine, warm oak, and textured linens, giving the space a foundation that feels light, organic, and timeless.







GEORGE ST

Organic Tailored Minimalism is defined by a fusion of softness and structure, creating minimalist spaces shaped by organic forms and refined with tailored precision.

Curved meets crisp through flowing lines such as arches and wave ceilings contrasted against clean, tailored edges, while a natural yet minimal palette highlights raw woods, stone, and textured fabrics.

Crafted calm is expressed through handcrafted elements that introduce quiet detail and intentional simplicity.

Organic accents inspired by biophilic shapes, plant forms, and seam-like detailing reinforce a connection to nature.

The concept is applied through architecture that blends sculptural curves with linear minimalism, interiors that embrace neutral tones, layered textures, and fluid silhouettes, and furniture that showcases tailored forms softened by organic contours.












