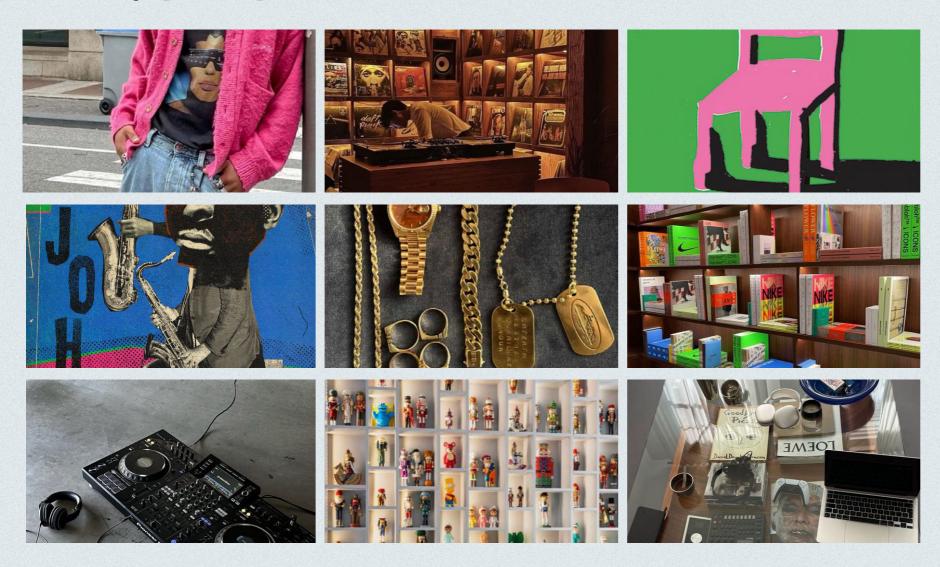


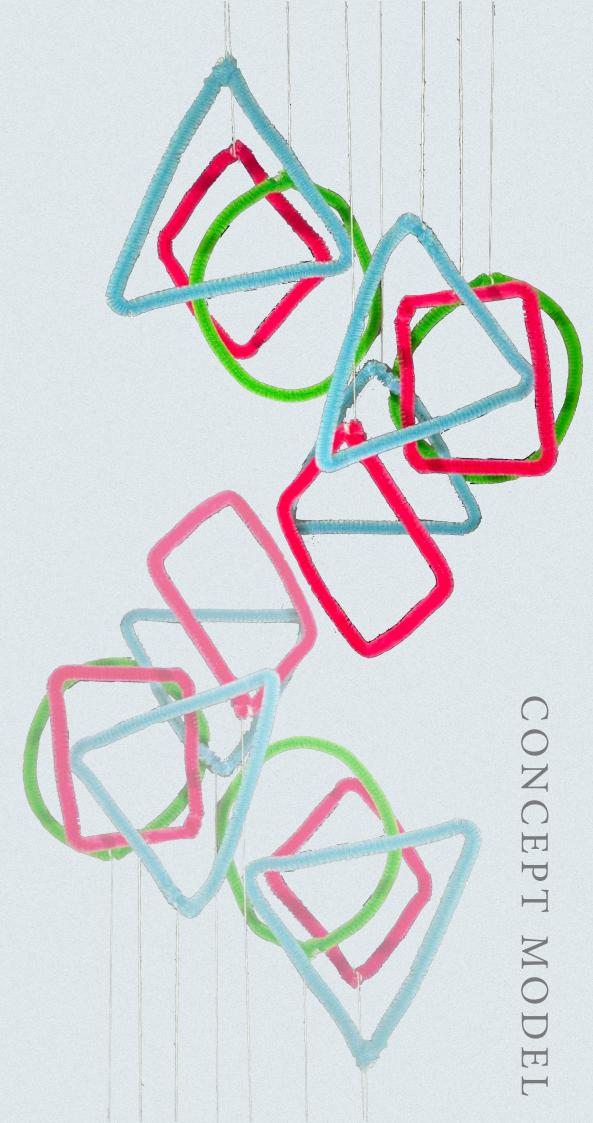


### Project 2 WOOLLOOMOOLOO HOUSE

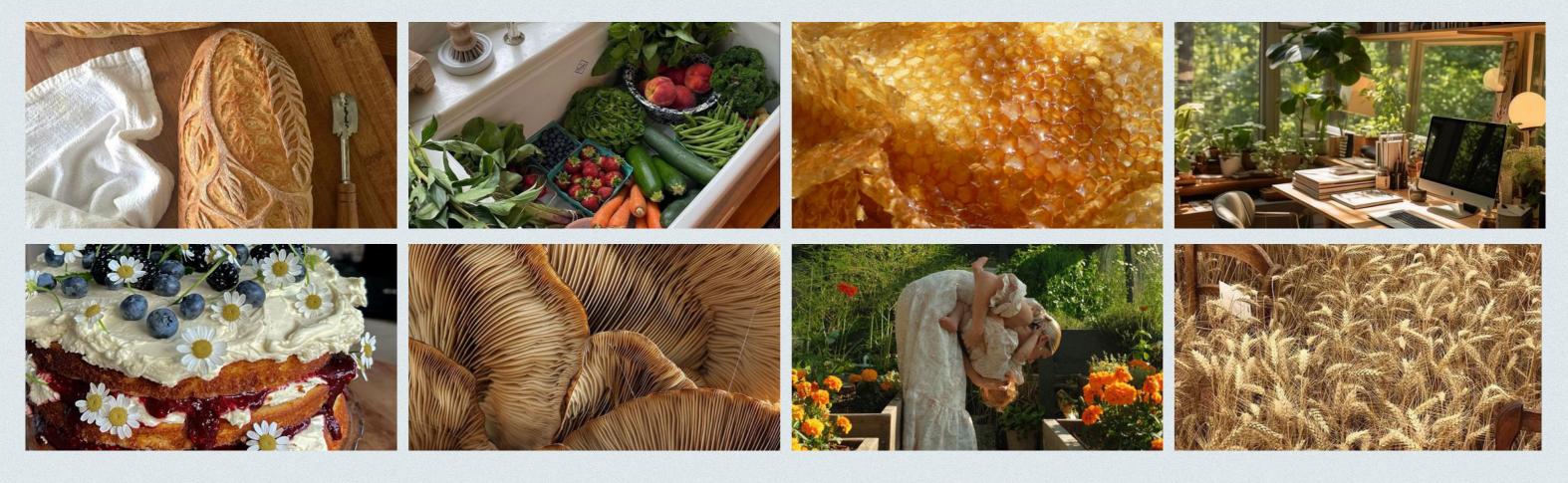




These clients lived in a single story house in Marrickville with one child. One works full time as a chef whilst the other works as a data analyst consultant.

# Project 5 GEORGE STREET REDFERN

#### Client Brief

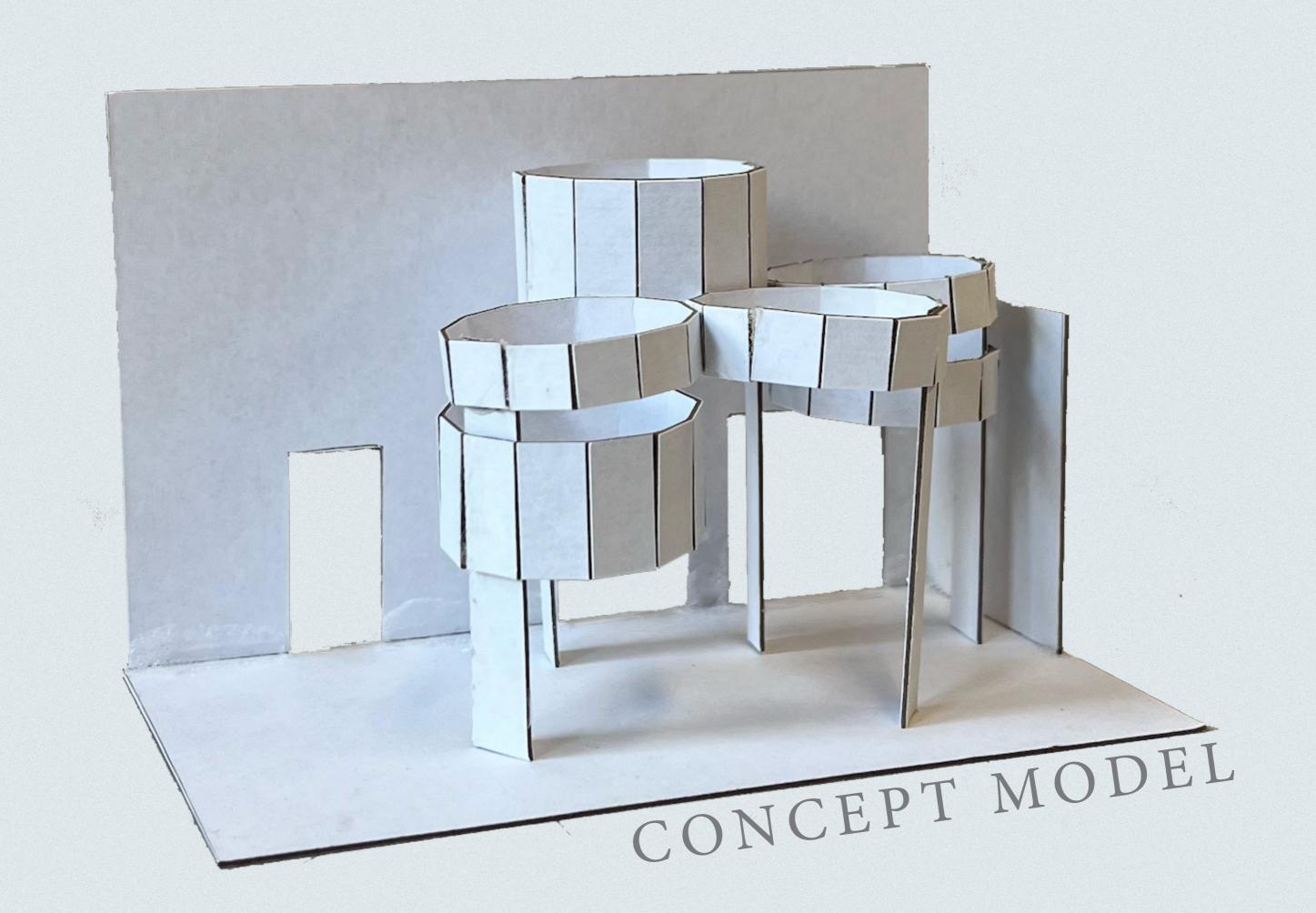
This target audience was broad. The redesign is to be used to promote ID+Co and the furniture showroom as internationally recognised interior design and suppliers, and should reflect an innovative, and exciting design response.

This is an iconic property built in 1870. It is a two storey warehouse and has been substantially refurbished over the years. It was originally built as a warehouse factory for J Heine's 'Dial' engineering works. Later in the 1990's it was adapted to become the Boutwell Draper art gallery, which included contemporary living and gallery space on the upper level and a ground floor showroom, gallery workspace. In 2015 the building had a major renovation to the ground and first floor. The fit-out included an interior design furniture showroom and office, with an expresso bar at the ground floor level.

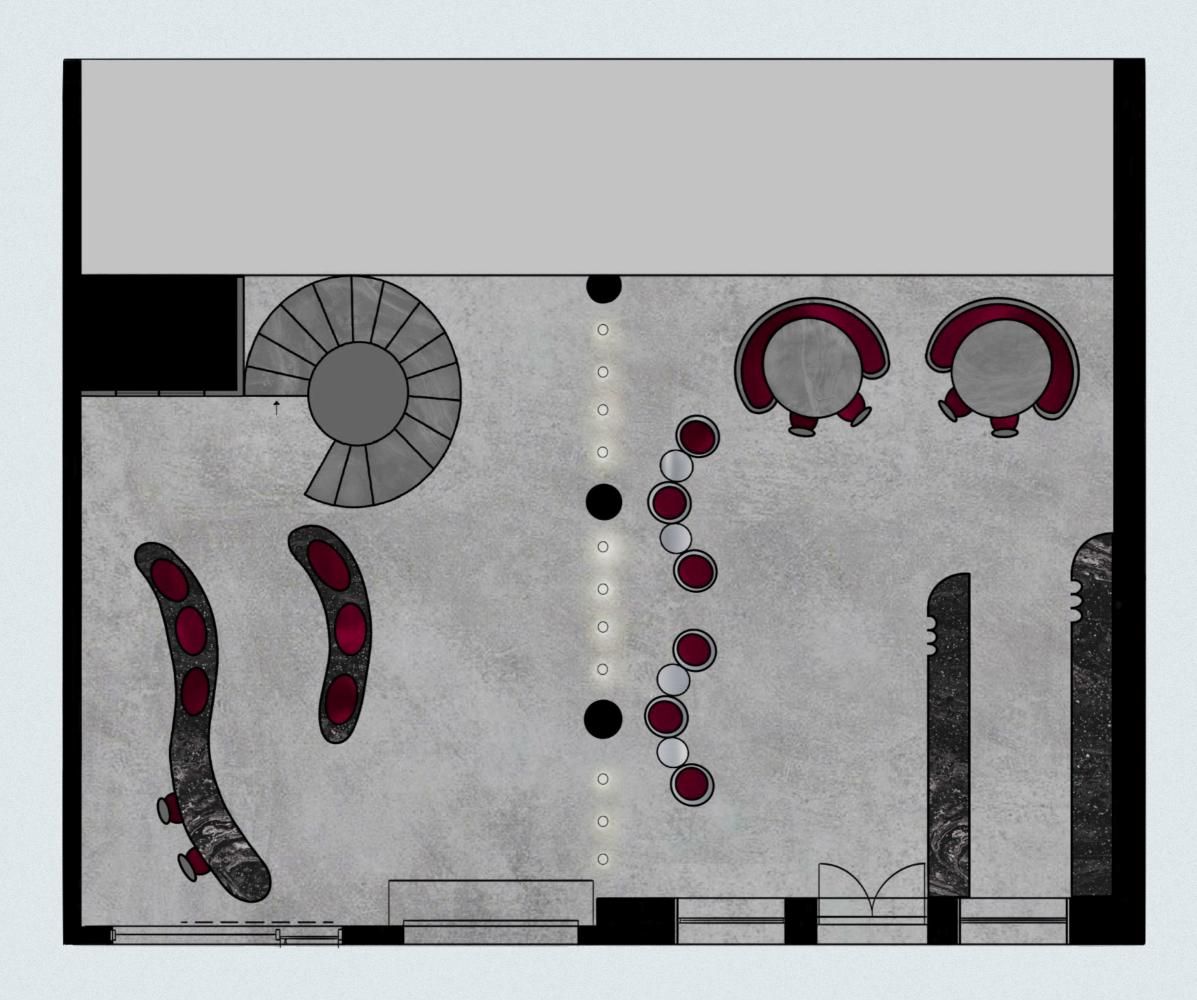
