





PROJECT BRIEF

The Boutique Hotel Tempe project involves the adaptive reuse of a heritage-listed 1939 Commonwealth Bank building in Sydney's Inner West. The goal is to transform the site into a vibrant, sustainable boutique hotel that reflects the area's eclectic culture and riverside heritage. The design concept, Coastal Heritage Connection, draws inspiration from the nearby Cooks River, incorporating natural materials, local artwork, and eco-conscious furnishings. Key spaces include a statement lobby, a tranquil prototype guest room, and a flexible retail area.

Connection with Water

Drawing inspiration from Sydney's coastal and riverine landscapes, this concept integrates the region's maritime and river history with modern design elements. The hotel evokes the feeling of a riverside retreat, with natural wood finishes, soft blue and white tones, and subtle nautical touches, while celebrating the connection to the Cooks River.

While Tempe is inland, it sits alongside the Cooks River, a waterway that links to Sydney's larger river and ocean systems, reflecting the city's historical ties to the sea and its rivers.

This riverside heritage will be woven into the hotel's design, creating a seamless connection between the land, the river, and the sea.



Through the use of natural materials, the concept merges the calming influence of the river with the vibrancy of modern Sydney culture. This design creates a tranquil and immersive environment where guests feel as though they've stepped into a riverside sanctuary, offering relaxation and connection to both the natural world and the historical significance of the region's waterways.

The atmosphere will blend modern luxury with a sense of grounded heritage, providing a peaceful retreat that celebrates both the past and the present of Sydney's riverside identity.

PROJECT BRIEF

This interior design project involves the transformation of a warehouse space at 250 Dowling Street into a sophisticated, multi-functional residence and showroom for a fashion agent. 
PARK RD, MARRICKVILLE

PROJECT BRIEF

This residential interior design project focuses on creating functional, sustainable, and visually cohesive spaces across the stairway, kitchen, and bathroom. Guided by the client's preference for a minimalist aesthetic and environmentally responsible materials, the design incorporatesethically sourced timber, natural stone, low-VOC finishes, and durable, non-toxic surfaces. Each area has been thoughtfully planned to maximise natural light, reduce environmental impact, and support the daily needs of a modern family. The result is a harmonious and practical design that balances aesthetics with sustainability.

BRIEF 1 - STAIRWAY




The stairwell design serves as both a functional connector and a visual feature within the home. Drawing from a palette of natural and industrial materials, the concept integrates New England Blackbutt timber for warmth, polished concrete for durability, and Laminex Surround panelling for texture and rhythm. Custom black metal rods form a sculptural balustrade that adds vertical emphasis, while integrated Elfa LED step lighting enhances safety and ambience. The result is a modern, cohesive staircase that enhances spatial flow while expressing craftsmanship and architectural interest.





BRIEF 2 - KITCHEN







The kitchen design combines warmth, practicality, and modern elegance. Timber flooring in New England Blackbutt provides a natural foundation, complemented by Fibonacci Stone in 'Wintersun' and glossy Alchemist Silk Flat tiles that add contrast and visual interest. Clean-lined fittings, such as a matte black Buildmat tap, sleek sink, and integrated appliances, were chosen for both performance and aesthetic appeal. This kitchen balances tactile materials with refined details, creating a space that is both highly functional and visually sophisticated.

BRIEF 3 - BATHROOM

The bathroom concept embraces a calming, spa-like atmosphere through a careful interplay of texture and tone. Hotham Tumbled Crazy Paving introduces organic irregularity underfoot, paired with soft matte white Futura tiles to maintain a fresh, airy feeling. Premium fixtures such as a freestanding bath and brushed metal tapware support a minimalist yet luxurious experience. This design delivers a tranquil retreat within the home—clean, grounded, and thoughtfully detailed to encourage rest and rejuvenation.
