



#### WOOLOOMOOLOO WAREHOUSE

OVERVIEW: Convert a warehouse into a three-level

home with one bedroom, a living area, and a kitchen. The design will highlight the building's industrial character, maximise natural light, and create flexible, inviting spaces that blend modern

comforts with industrial style.

KEYWORDS: Warehouse conversion, Three-level

home, Transperancy, Natural light



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#### **OBJECTIVE**

Transform a warehouse into a three-level home, featuring at least one bedroom, a spacious living area, and a fully equipped kitchen. The design will preserve the industrial character while incorporating modern comforts, with flexible spaces for work or leisure. Natural light will be maximised, and the raw structure will be showcased, creating a seamless flow between levels. The result will be a unique, inviting home that blends industrial style with warmth.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

Create a peaceful and practical space in Sydney that supports both work and downtime. The client needs a work area for emails, samples, and urgent tasks, with lighting that's easy on the eyes and perfect for colour rendering. They also want space for private showings, with a change room and room to display samples. The design should include some artwork, like a mural or floor piece, to add personality. For the meditation space, they'd love a calming vibe with lighting that feels like candlelight. The overall space should be comfortable, relaxing, and in tune with their lifestyle, reflecting their love of self-care, vegan living, and balance.

#### **CLIENT PROFILE**

The client is a respected fashion agent promoting Australian designers, often travelling for months. They see their Sydney home as a retreat for relaxation, self-care, yoga, meditation, and socialising, with a vegan diet. They need a work/consultant space for emails, samples, and urgent tasks, along with room for private showings, a change room, and sample display. The design should prioritise lighting with a focus on colour rendering index and include artwork, such as murals or floor applications. The meditation space should have a calming, candlelight-like ambiance.

#### FOCUS POINTS / CHALLENGES

The design focuses on a few key challenges. First, the stairs will be designed as dog-leg stairs to save space while still being practical and safe. Second, the floors need to line up with the existing windows to make sure there's plenty of natural light in the key areas, all while keeping privacy and energy efficiency in mind. Additionally, a zen meditation area is needed, big enough for yoga practice, to create a calming space that supports self-care.

The brief was to design the entry, lobby, **OVERVIEW:** 

stairs, lift, and café in a converted warehouse factory, creating a concept that honours the building's heritage while seamlessly connecting the lower and upper levels. The aim was to blend historical elements with modern function-

ality for a cohesive flow.

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#### **OBJECTIVE**

The objective of this project is to design key interior spaces within the selected building, focusing on the entry, lobby, and a new circulation system connecting the lower and upper levels. The design will honour the building's heritage while enhancing functionality through conceptual strategies, physical and digital modelling, and 3D visualisation. The goal is to develop and present at least two refined concept spaces, ensuring a cohesive and seamless connection between levels.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

The café must have seating for at least 20 patrons. The reception area should comfortably accommodate one staff member and up to four visitors. The stairs should serve as a key focal point, encouraging their use over the lift, which should play a more secondary role in the space.

#### **FOCUS POINTS**

The space must be designed to accommodate key functional needs, including seating for a minimum of 20 patrons in the café and a reception area that supports one staff member and up to four visitors. Circulation design should prioritise the use of stairs as a standout architectural feature, encouraging their use over the lift, which should maintain a more subtle presence within the space.

#### **CHALLENGES**

Key challenges include preserving the heritage-listed façade and retaining all structural elements, with the option to replace the entry roller door for improved access. The design must create a stronger connection between the lobby, showroom, and design studio, while accommodating a café with seating for at least 20 patrons.



#### FOCUS POINTS / CHALLENGES

There are a few challenges to consider in designing the lounge, kitchen and dining spaces. The high vaulted ceilings, while stunning, make hanging pendant lighting tricky, so careful thought is needed for placement and installation. With young kids in the home, it's also important to choose durable, child-friendly furniture that holds up to daily use but still looks stylish. The design needs to balance the client's desire for a peaceful, elegant retreat with the practicalities of family life, so selecting the right materials and creating flexible, functional seating arrangements is key. Finally, achieving a seamless indoor-outdoor flow while maintaining privacy and comfort adds an extra layer of complexity.



























FIRST FLOOR FLOORPLAN
